

UPDATE phonecall from Disney, April 2010

All persons entering the park will be screened with a metal detector.

There will be a bag check-in area for bags that are determined to be too large.

Prohibited to enter the park:

- Food and drinks
- Backpacks, bags, or purses larger than 8.5 x 11 inches

Prohibited attire:

- Costumes
- Home-made T-shirts
- Shirts with logos
- School logos
- Head coverings (hats, bandannas, knit caps)

Prohibited adornments:

- Sharp, spiky, pointy jewelry
- Heavy belts
- Heavy chains
- Towels, washcloths, bandannas

From the Disney web site:

Dress to Impress (Acceptable attire):

GIRLS

Dresses, skirts, shorts, casual pants (including jeans), blouses and tops, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots and flip flops)

GUYS

Casual pants (including khakis and jeans), shorts, shirts with collars (golf/polo and dress shirts), t-shirts with sleeves and in good condition, sport jackets, dress suits, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots, and flipflops)

This won't fly (Unacceptable attire):

- Any clothing affiliated with a school, professional sports team, group, club, area code, etc. (students only)
- Clothes not in good repair (ripped, torn, etc.)
- Revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suits, see-through clothing, cropped shirt that show midriffs)
- Hat or bandanas (either worn or hanging from belt loops/pockets etc.)
- Chains or oversized jewelry
