All persons entering the park will be screened with a metal detector.

There will be a bag check-in area for bags that are determined to be too large.

### Prohibited to enter the park:

Food and drinks

Backpacks, bags, or purses larger than 8.5 x 11 inches

### Prohibited attire:

Costumes

Home-made T-shirts

Shirts with logos

School logos

Head coverings (hats, bandannas, knit caps)

#### Prohibited adornments:

Sharp, spiky, pointy jewelry

Heavy belts

Heavy chains

Towels, washcloths, bandannas

Dress to Impress (Acceptable attire):

### **GIRLS**

Dresses, skirts, shorts, casual pants (including jeans), blouses and tops, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots and flip flops)

# **GUYS**

Casual pants (including khakis and jeans), shorts, shirts with collars (golf/polo and dress shirts), t-shirts with sleeves and in good condition, sport jackets, dress suits, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots, and flipflops)

This won't fly (Unacceptable attire):

- -- Any clothing affiliated with a school, professional sports team, group, club, area code, etc. (students only)
- -- Clothes not in good repair (ripped, torn, etc.)
- -- Revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suits, see-through clothing, cropped shirt that show midriffs)
- -- Hat or bandanas (either worn or hanging from belt loops/pockets etc.)
- -- Chains or oversized jewelry
